**DETAILS**

At approximately 0030 hours on 3/20/04, Officer Sellan and I were escorting Fire Chief Gomez on foot in the downtown area for the purpose of conducting bar inspections and safety checks. At approximately 0040 hours, we inspected Sangria and found the eastside of the business to be overcrowded with too many subjects crowding the dance floor and isles. Fire Chief Gomez advised Sangria personnel regarding the problem and Sangria personnel advised us that they would rectify the issue. After several checks of surrounding bars, Chief Gomez suggested a second check of Sangria to ensure the problems in the east room were corrected.

At approximately 0100 hours, we conducted a second check of Sangria. After conducting the second check, Chief Gomez, Officer Sellan, and I, agreed that the problems in the east room appeared to be compounding. After evaluating the east room for the second time, we agreed that an overcrowding / safety issue in the east room of Sangria (68 Pier) existed. Chief Gomez requested his department to respond to Sangria for an occupancy load check. Fire responded within approximately 10 minutes and conducted the appropriate check (see fire supplemental for details).

After the inspection, Fire Chief Gomez recommended Sangria be issued an overcrowding / hazardous condition citation for the east half of the business. Michael Santomieri, who stated he was a partial owner of Sangria, volunteered to accept the citation.
