Narrative

NOTIFICATION

On 11-18-06 at about 0146 hours, I received a call of a physical fight that was occurring in front of the Union Cattle restaurant located at 1301 Manhattan Avenue. Disptach advised that there were several subjects fighting on the sidewalk in front of the location. On 11-18-06 at about 0155 hours, I arrived on scene and found that the fight was over and that all subjects involved in the fight were gone upon my arrival. Employees at the location told me that there was a vehicle that was possibly involved and that the vehicle was now parked on Pier Avenue near Manhattan Avenue. Witnesses told me that the vehicle was orange and that it was an older model. Moments later, I observed the vehicle at the above location (lic [REDACTED]) and contacted the driver (NFD). The driver basically told me that he was driving past Union Cattle and his passengers began to yell at the crowd gathered on the sidewalk in front of the business. The driver told me that he stopped and his passengers exited the vehicle and walked over to the crowd where a verbal argument ensued. The driver told me that he did not know what the arguing was about. The driver said that he then left the area and did not know what happened

afterwards. At this time, I searched the area for any signs of a disturbance and was met with negative results.

CONTACT BY VICTIM/WITNESS

On 11-18-2006 at about 0200 hours, I was near the area of 11th Street and Hermosa Avenue investigating a separate incident when I was contacted by a female, later identified as Wit [REDACTED] R [REDACTED]. R [REDACTED] told me that her husband had been assaulted and that her husband and her friends were detaining the suspect at 50 11th Street. Due to fact that I was unable to leave the scene of the crime that I was investigating (suspect in-custody) and all other units were unavailable, I told R [REDACTED] that there was nothing that I could. I called for additional units to assist me. Moments later, a male subject with an injury to his eye approached me. This subject, later identified as the vic [REDACTED] R [REDACTED], was detaining another subject, later identified as the susp [REDACTED] Webb. R [REDACTED] told me that he had been assaulted by Webb and that he wanted to press charges for Assault. Due to the information that I was confronted with, I immediately detained Webb and placed him handcuffs. I told R [REDACTED] that I was unable to investigate the crime of battery at this time because I was extremely busy with other duties but that I would investigate it as soon as possible.

VICTIM STATEMENT

Moments later, Officer Gaines arrived on scene to assist with the investigation. Gaines contacted R [REDACTED] and obtained the following statement: R [REDACTED] told Gaines that he was standing on the sidewalk in front of the Union cattle when he heard a commotion. R [REDACTED] said that he was then suddenly struck from behind on his face, right eye area, by an unknown suspect. R [REDACTED] said that the suspect fled on foot and out of view. R [REDACTED] said that he began to walk to his vehicle which was parked at 50 11th Street. R [REDACTED] said that at this time, he encountered the suspect who assaulted him. R [REDACTED] said that he did not know if the suspect followed him or not. R [REDACTED] said that at this time he attempted to detain the suspect for a private arrest of PC 242 - Battery. R [REDACTED] said that the police was called again but that they did not show up. R [REDACTED] told Gaines that he saw a police officer near 11th Street and Hermosa Avenue and brought the suspect to this location. R [REDACTED] did not give no further information on how he was able to identify his attacker, since he did not see the person who assaulted him at Union Cattle. No further information.

MEDICAL TREATMENT

HBFD was summoned to the scene but R [REDACTED] medical treatment, see attached

PRIVATE PERSON'S ARREST

R [REDACTED] placed Webb under arrest for PC 242 - Battery, see attached forms.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Sometime during the time that R [REDACTED] attempted to detain Webb a fight ensued. During this time, R [REDACTED] vehicle was damaged, broken rear window (lic [REDACTED]). Susp-Webb was not interviewed.

Narrative

On 11-18-06 at approximately 0227 hours I (Droz) #173 arrived at 90 Pier Avenue to assist HBPD officers with a 242 PC, assault and battery investigation. I contacted a witness, [REDACTED] and she told me the following.

[REDACTED] said she was standing in front of the Union Cattle Company, 1301 Manhattan Avenue, with her husband [REDACTED] R [REDACTED]. An orange car, CA LIC# [REDACTED] pulled in front of the location with between five and six occupants inside of it. These occupants were yelling indiscriminately at people on the nearby sidewalk. One of these occupants exited the vehicle and challenged the victim to a fight. Security personnel from the Union Cattle Company prevented one suspect from hitting R [REDACTED] with a skateboard and another suspect from attacking R [REDACTED] with a knife. All parties then left the area.

[REDACTED] R [REDACTED] and the victim then walked to the Unit Block of 11th Street where their friend's car was parked. When they arrived at their friend's car, they were confronted by three of the same suspects who had confronted them in front of the Union Cattle Company. The suspect who was later arrested, [REDACTED] Webb, hit the victim with his fists approximately two times. Another suspect hit the victim with his fists approximately two more times. The victim did not fight back. This second suspect is described as either a Hispanic or Asian male, between 20 and 25 years old, 220 lbs, 5'5 tall, with no facial hair or glasses. He was last seen wearing a white t-shirt and blue shorts.

The victim and [REDACTED] R [REDACTED] then got inside of their friend's car. The second suspect used his elbow to smash the rear window to this vehicle. [REDACTED] R [REDACTED] then exited the vehicle and chased both subjects. He eventually caught [REDACTED] Webb, and the other suspect escaped. [REDACTED] R [REDACTED] then called the police.

It should be noted that a third subject was also with the two suspects during the assault. This subject was described as either a Hispanic or Asian male in his early 20's, 5'00, thick build, short black hair, with no facial hair or glasses. While running away from the scene of the assault, this subject stripped off his orange t-shirt and sweatshirt. His t-shirt had [REDACTED] CA [REDACTED] printed on the back of it.
