Narrative

I spoke with the victim, P [REDACTED], who related the following; P [REDACTED] stated that he was walking home to his residence and was traveling south bound on Bayview Dr. as he neared his home he noticed two male subjects following him. S-1 grabbed P [REDACTED] from behind by placing his right arm around P [REDACTED] neck. P [REDACTED] said he felt a hard object being pressed to the back of his head, S-1 then said "Don't move". S-1 then demanded money from P [REDACTED] - P [REDACTED], being in fear for his own safety, gave S-1 his wallet. S-1 removed the cash from P [REDACTED] wallet and then placed the wallet back in P [REDACTED] hand. During this time S-2 stood off to the side holding a skateboard. S-2 said "You don't want me to crack you with this". S-1 said something to the effect of "no hard feelings, we just need some money". The suspects then told P [REDACTED] to keep walking and not look back. P [REDACTED] did not see which direction the suspects fled.

P [REDACTED] stated S-1 was approx. 5'10" and possibly wearing a white "wife beater" t-shirt. NFI/NFD. P [REDACTED] believes S-2 was 6' tall and wearing dark colored "punk" style clothing that possibly had metal studs on portions of it. NFI/NFD. P [REDACTED] believes both suspects were white males. P [REDACTED] then walked to the area of the Pita Pit restaurant and contacted police. P [REDACTED] does not believe he can identify the suspects if seen again.

The victim then stated that he was grabbed from behind by one of the individuals, and felt an object pressed against his head. Fearing for his safety, the resident handed over his wallet. The second individual allegedly stood to the side, held a skateboard and said "You don't want me to crack you with this." After taking approximately \$100 in cash from the victim's wallet, he was then told to keep walking and not look back.
