The female victim is not desirous of prosecution and the second victim was transported to UCLA Harbor General Hospital for treatment of his injuries and was unable to provide a statement.

Narrative

On 12-30-06 at 0008 hours I (Droz) #173 was dispatched to The Dragon Bar, 22 Pier Plaza, regarding a 415(2) PC fight that had just occurred. I arrived at the above location and located two victims, [REDACTED] M [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] S [REDACTED]. M [REDACTED] had been pepper sprayed and S [REDACTED] had been attacked by multiple subjects. I contacted M [REDACTED] and she told me the following.

M [REDACTED] said that she was inside of The Dragon Bar. A verbal argument ensued between her and her sister, [REDACTED] M [REDACTED]. Another argument then ensued between friends of A [REDACTED] M [REDACTED] and a subject that she identified as [REDACTED] H [REDACTED]. A [REDACTED] M [REDACTED] said that H [REDACTED] was her sister's ex-boyfriend. She was unable to give any description or additional information regarding H [REDACTED]. M [REDACTED] M [REDACTED] then sprayed a chemical agent at A [REDACTED] M [REDACTED]. A [REDACTED] M [REDACTED] was unable to give a detailed description of the events surrounding this incident and appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. [REDACTED] M [REDACTED] said that she was not desirous of prosecution against [REDACTED] M [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] S [REDACTED] was then contacted by HBPD officers while being treated by the Hermosa Beach Fire Department for injuries sustained during a fight which was related to the above incident. S [REDACTED] was incoherent and not responsive to questioning, and appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. He did not give a statement. S [REDACTED] was transported by HBFD to Harbor General Hospital.

I then contacted a witness to the incident, [REDACTED] M [REDACTED], and he told me the following. M [REDACTED] is a doorman at Hennessey's Tavern, 8 Pier Plaza. He was standing near the front door of the above location and saw a fight erupt in the front patio area of The Dragon Bar. Two subjects who had been involved in the fight walked to the opposite side of Pier Plaza and contacted the subject which was later identified as [REDACTED] M [REDACTED]. One of these subjects was a Hispanic male wearing a dark shirt and the other was a thin Caucasian male wearing a white shirt. Maness then pointed to the victim who was later identified as [REDACTED] S [REDACTED]. Those two subjects attacked S [REDACTED]. A third subject, described as a thin Caucasian male wearing a dark jacket, joined the fight and assisted them. M [REDACTED] said these three subjects punched and kicked S [REDACTED]. He believes that S [REDACTED] was kicked in the head by at least one subject. S [REDACTED] and his three attackers then moved their fight to the intersection of Pier Avenue and The Strand. The three attackers left the area, possibly traveling toward the parking structure at 1301 Hermosa Avenue. M [REDACTED] does not know the identity of the three suspects.

I then contacted a second witness, [REDACTED] B [REDACTED], and he told me the following. B [REDACTED] is a doorman at The Dragon Bar. While inside of the establishment, he saw the subject who was later identified as M [REDACTED] M [REDACTED] talk with a Hispanic male who was wearing a blue and black striped shirt. The two subjects walked outside to the front patio area of the business. A fight then erupted in the patio area, between the male in the blue and black shirt, and the friends of M [REDACTED] M [REDACTED]. All involved subjects then left the patio area of The Dragon Bar. The male in the blue and black striped shirt and another subject approached A [REDACTED] M [REDACTED]. The male in the blue and black shirt then attacked S [REDACTED]. The remainder of B [REDACTED] statement and suspect description was consistent with the statement provided by M [REDACTED]. B [REDACTED] does not know the

identity of the suspects.

On 12-30-06 at approximately 0300 hours I contacted Harbor General Hospital, 1000 W. Carson Street, Torrance, CA, and interviewed Nurse [REDACTED] F[REDACTED] by telephone. F[REDACTED] told me that S[REDACTED] was in stable condition and sustained a "through and through laceration" to his lip. He also appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. She said that his injuries were not life threatening and that she expected him to be released from the hospital within twenty-four hours.
