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### Narrative

**Synopsis:** Suspect [REDACTED] punched Victim [REDACTED] in the face which broke his nose and caused severe bleeding. [REDACTED] also sustained a chipped front tooth and complained of a headache.

**Details:** On 12/22/07 at 0104 hours, I was working uniform patrol in a marked black and white police vehicle. I had a partner officer, Sergeant Jones, 128. As part of our duties, downtown foot patrol, we were standing on Pier Plaza, in front of Sangria, monitoring the bars and crowds. There were also two other officers working the same detail, Officer Higgins, 148, and Officer Frilot, 152.

I looked towards Sangria and saw Victim [REDACTED] stumble out of the patio while cupping his face with both hands. His hands and shirt were covered in bright red blood that poured from his nose and mouth area. I had [REDACTED] sit down on a nearby bench to prevent him from falling and further injuring himself. HBFD was requested to provide medical aid to [REDACTED]. Simultaneously Sergeant Jones, Officer Higgins, and Officer Frilot went into Sangria to look for other involved subjects / suspects.

I contacted [REDACTED] who essentially stated the following. He was inside Sangria and had just met and began speaking with IP [REDACTED]. Suddenly, he was punched in the face once by a male subject with long hair. He then stumbled out of Sangria. [REDACTED] added that he had not spoken with the suspect prior to the assault, and had overheard people saying that the suspect was [REDACTED] ex-boyfriend.

Officer Frilot returned to my location and informed me that the other involved party(s) had been escorted out the back door and had left the area. He then handed me a black Motorola Razor cell phone and said it had been dropped by the suspect during the altercation.

I held the flip style phone in my hand, with it flipped open. On the display there was a picture of a MWA subject and a MBA subject. [REDACTED] looked at the phone and spontaneously identified the MWA subject as the suspect who had just punched him in the face.

HBFD paramedics arrived on scene and provided medical aid to [REDACTED]. They noted he had a bloody nose, a chipped front tooth, and complained of a headache. I looked at [REDACTED] and saw that his nose was swollen. That, in addition to the heavy blood flow, caused me to believe his nose was broken. Despite the paramedic aid, [REDACTED] declined further assistance at a nearby hospital.

Sergeant Jones contacted [REDACTED] and obtained her statement, see attached supplemental report.

No operable digital cameras were available to photograph [REDACTED] injuries. I advised him to come into the HBPD station later the same day so a photograph could be taken.

I took possession of the cell phone and booked it into evidence, see attached property report.
