Background

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically Exempt, Pursuant to Section 15303, Class 3(b) and 15315 of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines with the finding that the project is in an area with available services.

At the March 21, 2000 meeting, the Planning Commission approved the proposed two unit condominium project. The project has not been constructed, and the tentative tract map will expire on March 21, 2002.

Analysis

The project consists of two detached units. Each with 3 bedrooms and 3 1/2 baths. The buildings are two stories above basement level garages. The buildings are designed in a contemporary architecture with some Mediterranean elements.

The two proposed condominiums meet all the current requirements of the Zoning and Subdivision Ordinances and Building Permits have been obtained. There is a need to extend the tentative tract map for the project because Resolution 00-12, Condition No. 13, causes the approved Vesting Tentative Parcel Map to expire two years from the date the Planning Commission approved the map (March 2000). The map can be extended when a request to the Planning Commission is made prior to the expiration date.
