PROJECT NO. CIP 00-172 21ST ST. STREET IMPROVEMENTS – APPROVAL OF PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, AND ADVERTISE FOR BIDS

Recommendation:

It is recommended that City Council:

- 1. Approve the plans, specifications, estimates, order the work and call for bids; and
- 2. Instruct the City Clerk to post a Notice Inviting Sealed Bids for said project.

Summary:

Project No. CIP 00-172 21st St. Street Improvement from Valley Drive to 150 feet west of Power Street is approved for Fiscal Year 2001-02. Staff requests that City Council approve the plans, specifications, estimates, and advertise for bids.

The plans, specifications, and estimates for Project No. CIP 00-172 have been approved by the Director of Public Works and are available in the Department of Public Works for review.

Background:

In January 2001, City Council approved the Professional Services Agreement between the City and CBM Consulting, Inc. for preparation of construction documents for this project.

In May, July and September 2001, the design issues and scope of work were reviewed by Public Works Commission and the residents. From these three meetings, the Commission, after evaluating the residents' comments and input, recommended the scope of work to Staff.

The proposed work consists of removing the pavement and concrete swale and reconstruction of pavement with compaction of sub-grade, re-pavement of roadway, concrete swale, traffic markings and construction of curb & gutter, sidewalk and concrete pavement at various locations.

On September 25, 2001, City Council approved the increase in the scope of work by including the cul-desac on 21st Street west of Power Street. This additional work was initiated on a request, via petition, from the residents of the cul-de-sac. The original limit for improvement was 21st Street from Valley Drive to Power Street.
