PROJECT NO. CIP 99-631 BEACH RESTROOMS REHABILITATION APPROVAL OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1. Approve the attached Professional Services Agreement between the City of Hermosa Beach and Gerson/Overstreet Architects in the amount of \$17,500;
- 2. Authorize the City Clerk to attest and the Mayor to execute said agreement, upon approval as to form by the City Attorney; and
- 3. Authorize the Director of Public Works/City Engineer to make changes to the contract in an amount not to exceed \$1.750.

Background:

On June 11, 2002, the City Council approved an agreement between the City and Gerson Overstreet/CMTS for the preparation of detailed design plans, specifications, cost estimates and other construction documents for architectural upgrades to the Community Center Theater. Gerson/Overstreet CMTS was selected through a competitive Request for Proposals (RFP) process for this work.

A project has been initiated to rehabilitate three beach restrooms. The scope of work consists of interior and exterior improvements to the restrooms located at:

- 2nd Street and the Beach
- 14th Street and the Beach
- 22nd Street and the Beach

The restrooms are more than thirty years old and are in great need of being rehabilitated.

In the interest of saving time and money, Staff is recommending that Gerson/Overstreet Architects be retained to prepare the plans, specifications, cost estimates and other construction documents for the proposed project. CMTS will not be associated with this project. Gerson/Overstreet has submitted a proposal to perform the work for a fee of \$17,500.

The general scope of services consists of preparation of the following:

- 1. Programming Phase
- 2. Schematic Design
- 3. Design Development
- 4. Construction Documents
- 5. Bid Phase
- 6. Construction Phase

The detailed scope of services may be found in Exhibit A of the attached Professional Services Agreement.

Fiscal Impact:

The FY 02-03 budget for this project is \$406,500 in Tyco Funds. After paying the \$17,500 for the architectural design and engineering, there will be \$389,000 available for construction.
