VACANCIES - BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS UPCOMING EXPIRATION OF TERMS

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the City Council direct the City Clerk to immediately advertise and request applications from interested parties for one Civil Service Board term that will expire July 15, 2002, with appointment to be made at the regular Council meeting of July 9, 2002.

Background:

One term on the Civil Service Board will expire July 15, 2002. Following established procedure, this matter is being brought to the attention of Council at this time for direction with regard to advertising the upcoming term expiration. Traditionally, Council has directed that all seats on all boards and commissions be advertised. (None of the other boards or commissions have terms expiring at this time - the Public Works Commission will have two expiring terms in October.)

The seat is currently held by John Wisdom, who has served on the Board since August 7, 1989, when he was appointed to fill an unexpired term. If interested in reapplying, Mr. Wisdom would be eligible for reappointment. Appointment will be for a four-year term ending July 15, 2006.

The vacancy will be advertised with an application-filing deadline of 6 p.m., Thursday, June 27, giving Council the opportunity to adjourn that evening's special meeting (proposed for review of the Economic Development Study) to an interview meeting prior to the July 9 regular meeting, if required.
