COOPERATION AGREEMENT

**Purpose:** RENEW COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE COMMUNITY  
DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION TO CONTINUE FUNDING THE PROJECTS  
TO REMOVE ARCHITECTURAL BARRIERS TO THE DISABLED AT  
PUBLIC FACILITIES.

**Recommendation**

- Approve by minute order the Cooperation Agreement with the Los Angeles County Community Development Commission (CDC).
- Authorize the City Manager to execute the Cooperation Agreement.

**Background**

On June 28, 1999 the City Council approved renewing the Cooperation Agreement with the Community Development Commission for funding proposed City projects under the Community Development Block Grant Program. Since 1999 the CDBG Program has been used to fund the City's compliance with Americans with Disabilities Act and for the utility undergrounding projects. In April 2002, the City Council executed a Reimbursable Contract with the CDC that will allow for the expenditure of allocated funds through June, 2003.

**Analysis**

The attached Cooperation Agreement is a renewal of the original three-year agreement to continue participation in the CDBG program.
