**PROJECT NO. CIP 01-167 STREET IMPROVEMENTS – CONCRETE  
PAVEMENT REPAIRS AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS  
AWARD CONTRACT**

**Recommendation:**

It is recommended that City Council:

1. Award the Construction Contract for CIP 01-167 Street Improvements – Concrete Pavement Repair at Various Locations to Damon Construction Co. in the amount of \$79,720;
2. Authorize the Mayor to execute and the City Clerk to attest the construction contract subject to approval by the City Attorney; and
3. Authorize the Director of Public Works to make changes in an amount not-to-exceed \$20,280.00.

**Background:**

The City Council approved an appropriation of \$100,000 in Capital Improvement Funds to cover the cost for CIP 01-167 Street Improvements – Concrete Pavement Repair at Various Locations.

On May 30, 2002, Staff released the specifications for bidding. This project was advertised in the Easy Reader and Green Sheet (Construction News Reporter). A total of two bid packages were picked up or mailed out to prospective bidders. On Thursday, June 13, 2002, the City Clerk received two bids. The bids were publicly opened and read aloud. The bid results are as follows:

<b><u>Firm Name</u></b>	<b><u>Bid Amount</u></b>
1. Damon Construction Co., Carson, CA	\$ 79,720.00
2. Western Superior, Sunland, CA	\$108,126.00

**Analysis:**

The apparent low bid of Damon Construction Co. is 20.28% lower than the engineer's estimate of \$100,000.00. Staff has reviewed the low bidder documents and has found them to be in order and Damon has recently completed projects in the City in a satisfactory

manner. Therefore, Staff recommends the award of this project to Damon Construction Co. (list of streets and location map attached).
