Recommendation:

That the City Council review and consider each of the following items and determine whether or not they will be placed on the ballot for consideration by the voters.

Background:

The following items have been set for discussion at this meeting for the City Council to determine whether or not they will be included on the November ballot. The City Council has already set a ballot measure to amend the Civil Service Ordinance to ask the voters whether or not the city should establish a veterans preference program for city employment.

Items to be included on the ballot will be placed on the agenda for the 7/22/03 meeting in the appropriate form for your review and approval by resolution.

Items for Consideration:

- 1. Bike Path West of Strand wall from Redondo Beach City limit to Manhattan Beach City limit where it would meet the existing separated bike path. This would be an advisory measure.
- 2. Hermosa Beach Pier End House. This would be an advisory measure that would ask the voters whether on not the City Council should consider the construction of a building on the end of the pier.

These items would be in addition to the consideration of whether or not to ask the voters to approve an increase in the business license tax and the transient occupancy tax, which are included under the Public Hearing item on this agenda.
