**PROJECT NO. CIP 00-191 14TH STREET LANDSCAPE PLANTERS
ACCEPTANCE**

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Accept the work by American Gardens for Project No. CIP 00-191 14th Street Landscape Planters;
2. Authorize the Mayor to sign the Notice of Completion; and
3. Authorize Staff to release payment to American Gardens (10% retained for 35 days following filing of Notice of Completion).

Background:

In March 2002, City Council approved an agreement with American Gardens for Project No. CIP 00-191 14th Street Landscape Planters. The scope of work included the removal of existing AC pavement and vehicular gate and installation of three landscape planters with color concrete, an irrigation system and a new vehicular gate.

The original scope of work included planting of trees and shrubs. However, City Council authorized the residents to plant trees and shrubs of their choice. The residents will be informed of the completion of construction.

The contractor has completed the work to the satisfaction of the Director of Public Works/City Engineer.

Fiscal Impact:

On March 14, 2002, City Council approved the construction contract in the amount of \$21,995 plus contingency of \$2,200. The project was completed for \$21,695.
