10	A. <u>Recitals</u>
11 12	(i) California Health and Safety Code Section 17922 requires all cities to adopt, as the City
13	Building Standards Code, the State Building Standards Code adopted pursuant to the provisions of
14	Chapter 4 of Part 2.5 of Division 13 of the California Health and Safety Codes.
15	(ii) Section 17958.5 of the California Health and Safety Code provides, in pertinent part, as
16 17	follows:
18 19 20	"a city or county may make such changes or modifications in the requirements contained in the provisions published in the State Building Standards Code and the other regulations adopted pursuant to Section 17922 as it determines, pursuant to the provisions of section 17958.7, are reasonably necessary because of local climatic, geological or topographical conditions."
21	(iii) Prior to making the modifications permitted under Section 17958.5 of the California
22	Health and Safety Code, this Council is required to make an express finding that such modifications or
23 24	changes are reasonably necessary.
25	(iv) This Council desires to amend the provisions of sections 103, 105, 107, 110, 310.7,
26	310.10, 904, 1503, 2409, 3301, Table 9-A, and Appendix Chapter 10 of the California Building Code,

19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FOUND, DETERMINED AND RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:	
20 21	1. In all respects as set forth in the Recitals, Part A, of this Resolution.	
21		
23	2. This Council does hereby expressly find and determine that the amendments set forth in	
24	Ordinance No, amending the "California Building Standards Code" and related publications, 2001	
25	Editions, including the amendments to the California Building Code regarding minimum dwelling unit size	
26	(Section 15.04.060 of the Hermosa Beach Municipal Code), roof covering requirements (Section	
27	15.04.080 of the Hermosa Beach Municipal Code), skylight frames (Section 15.04.090 of the Hermosa	
28		

1	Beach Municipal Code), fire extinguishing systems (Section 15.04.100 of the Hermosa Beach Municipal
2	Code), fire alarm systems (Section 15.04.110 of the Hermosa Beach Municipal Code) and premises
3	identification (Sections 15.40.010, 15.40.020, and 15.40.030 of the Hermosa Beach Municipal Code),
4 5	and also including the amendments to the California Fire Code regarding fire protection systems and
6	equipment, general safety precautions, fumigation, fuel dispensing, fire flow, hydrant spacing, and
7	fireworks (Sections 15.20.080 and 15.20.120 of the Hermosa Beach Municipal Code) are reasonably
8 9	necessary because of local climatic, geological or topographic conditions. This express finding is
10	supported and based upon the following more specific findings and determinations:
11	a. Located throughout the City of Hermosa Beach, as well as in the surrounding
12	cities, are numerous concentrations of structures.
13 14	b. The City of Hermosa Beach, as well as the surrounding cities, is located in an
15	area climatically classified as "arid" and prone to winds of high velocity. Moreover, due to the arid
16	nature of the area, the weather during the windy period tends to be very warm and dry. The dry weather
17 18	conditions are very hazardous to the surrounding highly populated areas in as far as flame spread is
19	concerned.
20	c. Because of the above-described climatic and meteorological conditions, the City
21	of Hermosa Beach and the surrounding cities have historically suffered from occasional structural fires.
22	These have often been difficult to control due to the dry winds carrying sparks and cinders to surrounding
23 24	structures.
24	
	d. The City of Hermosa Beach is located in a seismically active area and is in close
26 27	proximity to earthquake fault zones, and it is reasonably foreseeable that an earthquake would render the
28	City of Hermosa Beach particularly vulnerable to devastation.

e. Because of the above-described geological conditions within the city, the City of Hermosa Beach, in the event of an earthquake, may be unable to dispatch an adequate number of fire personnel and apparatus to suppress fires and conduct rescue operations. Moreover, the conditions within Hermosa Beach likewise occur in surrounding communities, hereby rendering mutual aid assistance problematic, at best.

f. Furthermore, as found in paragraph 2.b. of the above Resolution, climatic
 conditions within the community render it extremely likely that, in the event of high winds. and earthquake
 occurring, the City Fire Department would be unable to suppress numerous fires occurring throughout the
 community.

This Council does hereby expressly further find and determine that the amendments set
 forth in Ordinance No. _____, amending the "California Building Standards Code" and related
 publications, 2001 Editions, including the amendments to the California Building Code are reasonably
 necessary because of local climatic, geological or topographic conditions. This express finding is
 supported and based upon the following more specific findings and determinations:

a. The City of Hermosa Beach is located in a coastal region with predominantly sandy soil, requiring special care during excavations.

4. This Council does hereby expressly further find and determine that the amendments.set
forth in Ordinance No. _____, amending the "California Building Standards Code" and related
publications, 2001 Editions, including the amendments to the California Building Code regarding building
security (Section 15.04.050 of the Hermosa Beach Municipal Code) and minimum dwelling unit size
(Section 15.04.060 of the Hermosa Beach Municipal Code), including the amendments to the California
Plumbing Code regarding nonmetallic drainage piping (Section 15.16.040 of the Hermosa Beach

Municipal Code), garbage grinders (Section 15.16.050 of the Hermosa Beach Municipal Code), and 1 abandoned sewers (Section 15.16.060 of the Hermosa Beach Municipal Code), and including the 2 3 amendments to the California Electrical Code regarding condominium installations (Section 15.32.030 of 4 the Hermosa Beach Municipal Code) are reasonably necessary because of local climatic, geological or 5 topographic conditions. This express finding is supported and based upon the following more specific 6 7 findings and determinations: 8 a. The City of Hermosa Beach is located in a coastal region with a hilly topography, 9 resulting in a high level of concentration of structures and a high population density, making necessary 10 additional requirements to protect against criminal activity, overcrowded living conditions, excessive 11 12 noise, and other types of nuisances. 13 b. The City of Hermosa Beach has a mild climate, encouraging residents to spend a 14 large amount of time outside their residences, making necessary additional requirements to protect against 15 16 criminal activity, overcrowded living conditions, excessive noise, and other types of nuisances. 17 5. This Council does hereby expressly further find and determine that the amendments set 18 forth in Ordinance No. ____, amending the "California Building Standards Code" and related 19 publications, 2001 Editions, including the amendments to the California Electrical Code regarding 20 21 underground installations (Sections 15.32.040 through 15.32.120 of the Hermosa Beach Municipal 22 Code) are reasonably necessary because of local climatic, geological or topographic conditions. This 23 express finding is supported and based upon the following more specific findings and determinations: 24 25 a. The City of Hermosa Beach is located in an area climatically classified as "arid" and 26 prone to winds of high velocity. 27 28

1	6. This Council does hereby expressly further find and determine that the amendments set
2	forth in Ordinance No, amending the "California Building Standards Code" and related
3	publications, 2001 Editions, including the amendments to the California Building, Electrical, Mechanical,
4	Plumbing and Fire Codes regarding administrative provisions (Sections 15.04.020, 15.04.030,
5 6	15.04.040, 15.04.070, 15.12.020, 15.12.030, 15.16.020, 15.16.030, 15.20.080, and 15.32.020 of the
7	Hermosa Beach Municipal Code) are necessary to allow the application of the codes by procedures
8	suited to the size and nature of the City's staff and administrative agencies by means suited to the City's
9	experience with local climatic, geological, and topographical conditions and to provide sufficient support
10 11	for the time-consuming inspections and analysis required by the City's fire and geological hazards.
