**RESOLUTION NO.**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH,  
CALIFORNIA, DESIGNATING THE INTERSECTION OF LONGFELLOW AVENUE  
AND HIGHLAND AVENUE AS A THREE-WAY STOP CONTROL INTERSECTION**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Hermosa Beach, California, intends to continue to  
improve public convenience and safety, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that there is particular danger to motorists and pedestrians  
crossing at the intersection of Highland Avenue and Longfellow Avenue.

**NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERMOSA  
BEACH, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the intersection of Longfellow Avenue and Highland Avenue is designated  
as “Three-Way Stop Control Intersection” and the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to  
erect stop signs at all approaches to said intersection.

**SECTION 2.** That the Director of Public Works is authorized to remove all conflicting signs  
and curb markings.

**SECTION 3.** This resolution shall not become effective until appropriate signs giving notice  
of such three-way stop have been erected.
