**PROJECT NO. CIP 01-531 3rd STREET PARK – NEW CONSTRUCTION
APPROVAL OF PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS & ESTIMATES
AND ADVERTISE FOR BIDS**

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Approve the plans, specifications, estimates, order the work and call for bids; and
2. Instruct the City Clerk to post Notice Inviting Sealed Bids for said project.

Background:

The 2001-02 Capital Improvement Project Budget provides for construction of a new park at 3rd Street and Ocean View Avenue. Please see the attached Project Location Map.

On May 1, 2001, the conceptual drawing went before the Park & Recreation Commission for support and to receive public comments. After receiving design recommendations from the Commission, the plans, specifications and estimates were completed. On July 24, 2001, City Council directed Staff to incorporate the changes requested by the residents into the plans and specifications. The changes include rerouting the park pathway, connecting the sidewalk at the north end of Ocean View Avenue, addition of trees and shrubs, and shifting the park bench. These changes have been incorporated into the plans and specifications.

The general scope of work consists of removal of deteriorated asphaltic-concrete pavement, sidewalk, curb and gutter, and construction of concrete sidewalk, curb and gutter, irrigation lines, handrails and planting of trees and shrubs. Additionally, a bench will be installed in the park to provide a rest area.

The plans, specifications and estimates (PS&E) have been approved by the Director of Public Works and are ready for bid. The PS&E are available in the Department of Public Works for review.

Fiscal Impact:

No fiscal impact at this time.
