REQUEST TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PURCHASE PERSONAL PROTECTION EQUIPMENT FOR FIRST RESPONDERS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that Council:

1. Appropriate \$5,030.63 for a grant awarded to the City of Hermosa Beach through the Homeland Security Grant Program (2003-35, OES #037-00000). Authorize a budgeted revenue amount of \$5,030.63 for reimbursed expenditures associated with this grant.

BACKGROUND

The Police Department applied for a grant under the Homeland Security Grant Program in conjunction with the County of Los Angeles. This is the third in a series of grants obtained by the Police Department. The purpose of this grant is to purchase emergency protection equipment for first responders to deal with acts of bio-terrorism or other related acts of terrorism in this region of the South Bay. The Police Department will receive \$ 5,030.63.

ANALYSIS

The Police Department will purchase the equipment outlined in the grant application and then seek reimbursement for the equipment from the Office of Emergency Services in Sacramento, California.

FISCAL IMPACT

Under the terms of this grant, the City pays for the equipment outlined in the grant and then is reimbursed for these expenditures. Therefore there is no fiscal impact.
