## ORDINANCE NO. 04-1241 - "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 17.04 DEFINITIONS, AND CHAPTER 17.44 OFF-STREET PARKING, PERTAINING TO THE DEFINITION AND PARKING REQUIREMENTS FOR SNACK SHOPS."

Submitted for **adoption** and **waiver of full reading** is Ordinance **No. 04-1241**, relating to the above subject.

The following reflects the amendments that were made to the ordinance at the May 25 City Council meeting. Staff has lined through the text that was deleted, and underlined the text that has been added.

1. Section 17.04.050 Commercial Land Use Definition was amended as follows

"Snack shop or snack bar means a retail establishment with 25 or less seats that is distinguished from a restaurant as it does not include waiter/waitress table service, except queuing, (intermittent delivery of purchased goods) and does not serve full meals or have a kitchen capable of serving meals but instead serves snacks or non-alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises or for take-out usually for consumption between meals; specifically, items such as donuts and other baked goods, ice cream, yogurt, cookies, coffee, tea, and juices are considered snacks. and the Planning Commission may consider additional items as snacks."

2. Section 17.44.030(O) was amended as follows:

"The parking requirements for a snack bar and or snack shop shall be the same as that for a restaurant, unless it can be shown to the Planning Commission that the characteristics of the building; its location, <u>size</u> and other mitigating factors such <u>as limited service area relative to gross floor area and limited seating</u> <u>capacity</u> result in less parking than necessary for the business demand than for a restaurant use. In these cases the Planning Commission may consider the retail commercial requirement for parking, pursuant to Section 17.44.210 Parking Plans."

## ORDINANCE NO. 04-1241

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 17.04 DEFINITIONS, AND CHAPTER 17.44 OFF-STREET PARKING, PERTAINING TO THE DEFINITION AND PARKING REQUIREMENTS FOR SNACK SHOPS

The City Council of the City of Hermosa Beach does hereby ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1**. The Planning Commission held a duly noticed public hearing on February 18, 2003, to consider amending the Zoning Ordinance definition and parking requirements for snack shops to more clearly distinguish snack shops from restaurants.

**SECTION 2** The City Council held a duly noticed public hearing on January 27, 11 12 2004, to consider the recommendation of the Planning Commission to amend Sections 13 17.04.050 and 17.44.030(O) of the Zoning Ordinance pertaining to definition and parking 14 requirements for snack shops and referred the matter back to the Planning Commission for 15 16 further consideration. The Commission, after further deliberation, did not modify their 17 original recommendation. The City Council again considered the original recommendation 18 of the Planning Commission at the meeting of May 11, 2004 and continued the hearing to 19 May 25, 2004 and directed staff to provide survey information about the operations of snack 20 21 shops in the city and in adjacent cities.

SECTION 3 The subject text amendment is exempt from the requirements of the
California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), pursuant to the general rule set forth in
Section 15061(3) of the CEQA Guidelines, as there is no possibility that these
modifications to the Zoning Ordinance may have a significant effect on the environment.

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	Section 4. Based on the evidence considered at the public hearing and the final
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2	recommendation of the Planning Commission after reconsideration the City Council hereby
3	ordains that the Hermosa Beach Municipal Code, Title 17-Zoning, be amended as follows:
4 5	1. Amend Section 17.04.050 Commercial Land Use Definition to read as follows:
6	"Snack shop or snack bar means an establishment with 25 or less seats that is
7	distinguished from a restaurant as it does not include waiter/waitress table service,
8 9	except queuing, (intermittent delivery of purchased goods) and does not serve full
10	meals or have a kitchen capable of serving meals but instead serves snacks or non-
11	alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises or for take-out; specifically,
12	items such as donuts and other baked goods, ice cream, yogurt, cookies, coffee,
13	tea, and juices are considered snacks."
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16	2. Amend Section 17.44.030(O) to read as follows:
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18	"The parking requirements for a snack bar and or snack shop shall be the same as
19	that for a restaurant, unless it can be shown to the Planning Commission that the
20	characteristics of the building; its location, size and other mitigating factors such
21	as limited service area relative to gross floor area and limited seating capacity
22	result in less parking demand than for a restaurant use. In these cases the Planning
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24	Commission may consider the retail commercial requirement for parking, pursuant
25	to Section 17.44.210 Parking Plans."
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1	SECTION 12. Prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days after the date of its
2	adoption, the City Clerk shall cause the summary to be published in the Easy Reader, a
3	weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Hermosa
4	Beach.
5 6	SECTION 13. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this
7	ordinance, shall enter the same in the book of original ordinances of said city; shall make
8	minutes of the passage and adoption thereof in the records of the proceedings of the City
9 10	Council at which the same is passed and adopted.
