<u>VACANCY – BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS – APPOINTMENT TO</u> PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the City Council appoint from among the applicants interviewed earlier this evening to fill three expired terms on the Public Works Commission.

Background:

Three terms on the Public Works Commission will expire October 31, 2004. At its meeting of August 10, 2004, the City Council directed that the City Clerk advertise for applicants for the three seats. Notice was posted at City Hall and published in the Easy Reader August 19 and 26, with an October 5 deadline for submitting applications. All three appointments will be for full four-year terms ending October 31, 2008.

At its meeting of October 12, the Council scheduled a meeting for 6:00 p.m. prior to the October 26 regular meeting for the purpose of interviewing the five applicants – all were notified by telephone and mail of the date, time and place of the scheduled interviews.
