## AWARD PURCHASE OF NEW PUBLIC WORKS VEHICLE

## **Recommendation:**

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1. Award the purchase of one (1) Chevrolet Trail Blazer to Wondries Fleet Division of Alhambra, California, in the amount of \$25,988.53; and
- 2. Authorize Staff to issue the appropriate purchase documents as required.

## Summary:

Public Works vehicles are part of the inventory in the Vehicle Replacement Fund. The 1989 Chevrolet Astrovan used by Equipment Service Division personnel is identified in the FY 04-05 Adopted Budget as scheduled for replacement and \$26,250 has been allocated for this purpose.

Staff recommends that Council authorize the purchase of this vehicle from Wondries Fleet Group of Alhambra, California as they hold the sole contract (Bids #0364375 and #207488) with the County of Los Angeles. They are also the provider of many Public Works vehicles in the County fleet.

Since Wondries Fleet Group has an established government contract with the County, City policy allows the purchase of equipment from a sole source vendor under these conditions. This is considered a "piggyback" purchase and is standard within the industry.
