## **ORDINANCE NO. 05-1248**

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE, SECTION 17.50.010, TO ALLOW NON-COMMERCIAL SPEECH ON COMMERCIAL SIGNS

## || The City Council of the City of Hermosa Beach does ordain as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The Planning Commission held a duly noticed public hearing on March 15,
2005, to consider amending the Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 17.50, to allow sign owners to substitute
non-commercial sign speech on commercial signs and recommended that said section be amended.

9 <u>SECTION 2</u>. The City Council held a duly noticed public hearing on April 26, 2005, to
10 consider the recommendation of the Planning Commission to amend the Zoning Ordinance, Chapter
11 17.50, to allow sign owners to substitute non-commercial sign speech on commercial signs.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. Based on the evidence considered at the public hearing and the record of the
Planning Commission, the City Council makes the following findings:

The Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 17.50, Signs, currently is not consistent with case law
regarding non-commercial speech as it favors commercial speech.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. Based on the foregoing, the City Council hereby ordains that the Hermosa
Beach Municipal Code, Title 17-Zoning, Chapter 17.50 be amended as follows:

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Amend Section 17.50.010 by adding sub-section D as follows:

<sup>19</sup> "D. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code, any noncommercial copy may be <sup>20</sup> substituted for any commercial copy on any sign permitted by this Code. If noncommercial sign <sup>21</sup> copy is substituted, the resulting sign will continue to be treated as the original commercial sign <sup>22</sup> under this Code and will not be deemed or treated as on off-premises sign. The content of any <sup>23</sup> noncommercial copy on any sign otherwise permitted by this Code may be changed without <sup>24</sup> complying with any provisions of this Code normally required for sign copy or design approval."

25 <u>SECTION 5</u>. This ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect from
26 and after thirty (30) days of its final passage and adoption.

27 <u>SECTION 6</u>. Prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days after the date of its adoption, the
28 City Clerk shall cause this ordinance to be published in the Easy Reader, a weekly newspaper of

general circulation published and circulated, in the City of Hermosa Beach in the manner provided
by law.

3	SECTION 7.	The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this ordinance,
4	shall enter the same in the book of original ordinances of said city, and shall make minutes of the	
5	passage and adoption thereof in the records of the proceedings of the City Council at which the	
6	same is passed and adopted.
