**REQUEST FROM HISTORICAL SOCIETY TO INSTALL A SIGN ON THE

**Recommendation:**

**Background:**

We received a request from the Historical Society to install a sign above the entrance to the Historical Museum. A copy of the proposed sign is attached.

The City Council, as the property owner, needs to provide its consent to file the application to install the sign with the Planning Commission. This is a similar process that we follow in other situations when an application is required to the Planning Commission.

If permission is granted, the Historical Society would then file an application with the Planning Commission to install the sign.
