7	WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Hermosa Bea	
	California, on Tuesday, November 8, 2005, at which there will be submitted to the voters	the
8	following measure:	
9	Shall an ordinance be adopted adding the beach to the Restricted Open YES	
10	Space (O-S-1) zone and limiting improvements in the O-S-1 zone to (a) landscaping, irrigation and erosion control, and (b) replacement or NO	
11	repair of existing improvements within their existing footprint?

13	NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERMO	SA
14	BEACH, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AN ORDER AS FOLLOWS:	
15	ORDER AS FOLLOWS.	
16	<u>SECTION 1</u> . That pursuant to Section 9219 of the Elections Code of the State	of
17	California, the persons filing an initiative petition have first priority to file a written argument	in
18	favor of the ordinance, and the City Council has first priority, if it chooses, to submit	an
19	argument against the ordinance.	
20	<u>SECTION 2</u> . That the Hermosa Beach City Council hereby authorizes Councilment	ser
21	to: (1) write the argument against the measure specified above, with	all
22	Councilmembers invited to sign; (2) file the written argument, accompanied by the print	ted
23	name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, in accordance with Article 4, Chapter	3,
24	Division 9 of the Elections Code of the State of California; and (3) change the argument un	ntil
25	and including the date fixed by the City Clerk, after which no arguments for or against the C	ity
26	measures may be submitted to the City Clerk. The argument shall be accompanied by the Fo	rm
27	of Statement To Be Filed By Author(s) of Arguments.

If signed on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization and the printed name
and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument must be
included with the argument.

4	SECTION 3. That the City Council directs the City Clerk to transmit a copy of the
5	measure to the City Attorney, unless the organization or salaries of the office of the City
6	Attorney are affected. The City Attorney shall prepare an impartial analysis of the measure
7	showing the effect of the measure on the existing law and the operation of the measure. If the
8	measure affects the organization or salaries of the office of the City Attorney, the City Clerk
9	shall prepare the impartial analyses. The impartial analyses shall be filed by the date set by the
10	City Clerk for the filing of primary arguments.
11	SECTION 4. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this
12	Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
