AWARD PAINTING OF STREETLIGHT POLES AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS ON HERMOSA AVENUE

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1. Award the contract to paint streetlight poles on Hermosa Ave. at various locations to Everlast Painting Co. of San Pedro in the original bid amount of \$6,600;
- 2. Authorize addition of protective coating to streetlight poles at an additional cost of 4,500;
- 3. Authorize issuance of the appropriate purchasing documents; and
- 4. Authorize the Director of Public Works to make changes to the agreement up to \$900.

Summary:

Specifications were prepared and requests for bid notices were sent to four (4) interested and qualified companies. In addition, this project was advertised in the Easy Reader. On Monday, January 30, 2006, a mandatory pre-bid meeting and site inspection were held. On Thursday, February 9, 2006, the City Clerk received four bids which were publicly opened and read aloud. The bid results were as follows:

It was determined that since the lowest responsible bidder's proposal was well within the amount budgeted for this project, an second coat of urethane, at a cost of \$4,500, which would extend the life of the painted poles and at the same time protecting the new look, could be added.
