

**AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT WITH CROSSROADS SOFTWARE**

**RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that Council:

1. Authorize an amendment to the contract with Crossroads Software, Inc to extend the date to December 31, 2006.


**BACKGROUND**

The Police Department was awarded a grant through the Office of Traffic Safety for electronic ticket writers, traffic collision management and reporting, and DUI enforcement. This grant involved ten South Bay agencies including Hermosa Beach. Crossroads Software, Inc. was awarded a contract to work on this grant and the contract ran from October 1, 2004 to December 31, 2005. An extension of the grant with the Office of Traffic Safety was approved to complete all of the goals and objectives of the grant. The contract with Crossroads expired and was not amended at the time, however, Crossroads has presented an extension, which needs to be approved to comply with the requirements of the Office of Traffic Safety. The Office of Traffic Safety requires a valid contract before payments can be made on the grant.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

There is no fiscal impact for extending the contract with Crossroads. The original amount of the grant and contract will stay the same.
