**CENTENNIAL BRICK SIGN**


**Recommendation:**

That the City Council approve appropriation in the amount of \$3,000 from the Centennial fund for the purchase and installation of a concrete monument sign to be placed adjacent to 14<sup>th</sup> Street where the bricks will be placed.

**Background:**

As you know, the sidewalk on 14<sup>th</sup> Street adjacent to Noble Park is the site of the Centennial Brick Walkway. Over 200 bricks have been sold and the first order has been placed. This group will be installed when they arrive. The sign will be similar to the one that we installed for the Millennium Walkway in 2000. The Centennial sign, like the Millennium sign, is located in the right-of-way adjacent to the sidewalk. The amount of \$3,000 will cover the purchase of the sign at \$2,000 and the installation.
