BEACH VOLLEYBALL COURT RELOCATION
--

Recommendation

Staff recommends that Commission consider resident request to relocate two (2) beach volleyball courts situated at 29th Street and the Strand.

Background

The Community Resources Department received a letter of request from Arthur Mazirow (Attachment C) dated September 29, 2004. Mr. Mazirow has requested relocation of the courts to measure 50-feet west of the Strand wall. The court currently measures at 23-feet from the Strand wall. The purpose of Mr. Mazirow's request is to put distance between his residence and noise emanated from the course of volleyball play and associated social gathering.

Analysis

In coordination with the Departments of Public Works and Community Resources the Parks and Recreation Commission instituted a Beach Volleyball Court Policy and Application form in 1997 (Attachment B). The policy includes a Court Specification Sheet that stipulates minimum distance from the Strand wall at 50-feet. However, courts that did not comply with this measurement at the time of policy development were 'grand fathered' in at distances of less than 50-feet. Within the caveat of this policy, the courts at 29th Street were approved at a distance of 23-feet.
