Centennial Celebration Community Center Mural Project and Handprint Wall

Recommendation

Staff recommends that Commission approve proposal for a Community Center Mural Project and a Handprint Wall.

Background

The Department of Community Resources received a letter of request from Richard McCurdy, Project Manager, proposing two separate Centennial projects for the Community Center.

The Mural Project is proposed for temporary display on the east side of the Community Center. Resident youth will work with design artist, PJ Pauley, to paint the mural on canvas, which later will be displayed on the east side of the building.

The Handprint Wall will be temporarily located on the concrete retainer wall beneath the skate track. Participants will pay to place their color-painted handprints on the wall. At the end of Centennial celebrations, the wall be painted back to its original state.
