- 1. Kay Etow Park
  - Replace missing sign
  - Install dog-mitt dispenser
  - Plant new ground covering
  - Replace benches
- 2. South Park
  - Repair/remove hockey rink
  - Repair top fence of rink wall
  - Install entrance sign and consider name change to Centennial Park
  - Upgrade playground area and install rubber surfacing to replace sand
  - Install dog-mitt dispenser on west side of park
  - Upgrade irrigation system and overall maintenance
  - Small ball field south east corner
- 3. Bi-Centennial Park
  - Remove Building
  - Replace picnic benches and table with concrete base
- 4. Clark Stadium
  - Create a master plan for long-term use
  - Push back baseball field perimeter to increase size
  - Install new lights to decrease or eliminate overspill
- 5. Fort Lots O Fun
  - Install painted cross walk at Prospect & 6<sup>th</sup> Street
  - Consider options for Prospect School building
- 6. Valley Park
  - Impressed with renovations
- 7. Sea View Park
  - Replace entrance gate
- 8. Edith Rodaway Friendship Park
  - Monitor scheduled improvements to seating and basketball courts
