**PRESENTATION OF FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS
NORTHEAST HERMOSA TRAFFIC STUDY**

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Public Works Commission receive the presentation and provide direction to Staff.

Summary:

On November 28, 2001 the residents of the northeastern section of Hermosa Beach were invited to meet with City Staff and representatives of Katz, Okitsu & Associates (KOA), the firm selected to do the study. The residents voiced their concerns, opinions and made suggestions as to what they'd like to see happen with regard to the streets in their neighborhood.

On March 4, 2002, the residents were again invited to attend a neighborhood forum to hear the results of the data collection phase of the study and review the range of possible solutions to the alleged traffic problems.

Tonight, Joel Falter, Senior Transportation Engineer for KOA, will present their findings and recommendations.
