**REQUEST FOR TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES ON GOULD AVENUE
BETWEEN VALLEY DRIVE AND SEPULVEDA BOULEVARD**

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Public Works Commission receive and file this report.

Summary:

At both the February 19 and April 16, 2003 meetings, the Commission received reviews from the City Traffic Engineer and comments from residents regarding speeding on Gould Avenue between Valley Drive and Sepulveda Boulevard.

One issue noted in the discussions was the traffic signal at the intersection of Sepulveda Boulevard/Pacific Coast Highway and Artesia Boulevard/Gould Avenue and the possibility of shielding the signal or changing the timing of the right turns.

The Public Works Department has not yet received word back from Caltrans regarding the intersection and will report back to the Commission once the information has been received.
