**REQUEST FOR SPEED HUMPS ON LOMA DRIVE  
BETWEEN 6<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND END OF STREET**

**Recommendation:**

It is recommended that the Commission deny the request for speed humps on Loma Drive between 6<sup>th</sup> Street and its southerly terminus (cul-de-sac).

**Summary:**

A request has been received for the City of Hermosa Beach to consider the installation of speed humps on Loma Drive from 6<sup>th</sup> Street south to the end of the street. Staff has reviewed this request and has determined it to be ineligible for speed humps because this segment is only 200' in length. Staff, therefore, is recommending that the Commission deny the request.

Cul-de-sacs are specifically mentioned in the CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS portion of the *Speed Humps Policies, Guidelines, and Procedures*, page 2, where it states: "Speed humps will not normally be installed in isolated blocks along a continuous street, or on relatively short (less than 800 feet) cul-de-sac-streets."
