MAINTENANCE

The maintenance function of the Public Works Department is divided into the following sections:

- Building Maintenance
- Equipment Service
- Parks/Medians

- " Sewers/Storm Drains
- Street Lighting
- ** Street Maintenance/Traffic Safety

Building Maintenance: Repaired damage to stalls and ceiling in dog shed; removed graffiti from Strand restrooms, Community Center and South Park; painted Lawn Bowling Club fence poles; changed marquee; repaired stairs at 6th and Prospect; replaced valves at Valley park; set up and tore down Council Chambers as needed throughout the month; started remodel of Police Department storage area.

Equipment Service Division: Prepared new Police Department units; repaired 4x4 units; repaired speed trailer; performed brake inspections and repairs; performed ongoing vehicle repairs; reviewed permits with AQMD inspector; started new system record keeping; coordinated removal of material from 6th & Prospect for auction.

Parks/Medians Division: Ongoing median and park contract administration; repaired irrigation at Clark, Noble, and South Parks and the Greenbelt; replaced the swing set at 2nd and Beach Dr.; set up Valley Park and Clark Field for soccer season; replaced backboards and installed new fence at the Lawn Bowling Club; repaired drinking fountains on the Greenbelt; trained for locator units.

<u>Sewers/Storm Drain Division</u>: Installed new deodorant blocks in storm drains; cleaned up catch basins after Fiesta downtown; inspected and repaired caterpillar; inspected pump stations with engineer.

<u>Street Lighting Division</u>: Installed and removed banners; started citywide traffic counter program; installed new wire conduit breakers for South Park lighting; repaired street lighting at Pier & Bayview; repaired lights at 18th and 35th on the Strand.

<u>Street Maintenance/Traffic Safety Division</u>: Installed new STOP bars, signs and legends on Palm Drive from 28th to 35th Streets; moved handicap spaces at Clark Building; repaired sidewalks on Hermosa Ave. at 1st and 5th Streets; assisted with *Picnic in the Outfield*; repaired meter poles at various locations citywide.
