**REQUEST FOR STOP SIGN ON 8<sup>TH</sup> PLACE AT OCEAN DRIVE**

**Recommendation:**

It is recommended that the Public Works Commission approve the installation of stop signs on 8<sup>th</sup> Place at Ocean Drive.

**Summary:**

Staff received a request from a resident to install stop signs on 8<sup>th</sup> Place at Ocean Drive. At this time there are stop signs on Ocean Drive at this intersection. The street slopes steeply toward PCH from Prospect Avenue and a stop sign would significantly help to slow traffic speeding down the hill.

Staff concurs with this request and recommends approval. Sergeant Thompson of the HBPD is quite familiar with the location and recommends approval as well. Residents along this street have been notified of the hearing and we will receive public testimony. If the Public Works Commission agrees with staff, the requested stop signs will be installed.

The residents also requested speed humps but the street grade is too steep to allow them.
