**PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON SOUTH SIDE OF 27TH STREET
ADJACENT TO VALLEY PARK**

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Public Works Commission hold a public hearing to consider parking restriction options on south side of 27th Street adjacent to Valley Park.

Summary:

Since the reopening of Valley Park, there has been a growing concern that there is not enough parking available for park users and that the majority of parking spaces are taken up by resident parking from the surrounding area. Residents have utilized this parking for a long time and will understandably be concerned about losing any parking. The recent park renovation project did add approximately 6 additional parking spaces. One option to consider would be to provide six (6) parking spaces with a 6-hour restriction (8 am – 10 pm) similar to Valley Drive.

Staff mailed a notice of this Public Hearing to residents and property owners in the vicinity that would likely be affected by this propose change.
