DISABLED PARKING SPACES

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Public Works Commission:

- 1. Receive public comment; and
- 2. Approve the revised guidelines for installing disabled parking spaces for residents in the public right-of-way.

Summary:

The notice for this public hearing was published in the Easy Reader on September 15, 2005 (Attachment 1). In addition, notices were posted at each existing residential handicapped parking space in the City.

After receiving public comment, the Commission will consider the draft policy prepared by the Commission subcommittee (Attachment 2). In addition to policy considerations, it is requested that the Commission make recommendation on the issue of whether existing spaces would be grandfathered or made subject to revised requirements.

Once approved by the Commission, the revised guidelines developed by the Public Works Commission will be presented to the City Council for adoption.

GUIDELINES FOR REQUESTING A DISABLED PARKING SPACE

The City of Hermosa Beach recognizes that there are certain locations within the City that do not provide sufficient and/or accessible off-street parking. In those cases, a limited number of on-street parking spaces may be designated for the benefit of residents with an identifiable need for disabled parking without significantly affecting the available curb parking in an area.
