LIGHTING IN NOBLE PARK

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Public Works Commission hear public testimony and approve the installation of a new street light in the center of Noble Park.

Summary:

Staff has received a letter from a resident living adjacent to Noble Park expressing concerns for safety at night when there are loitering individuals in the park. This resident feels that the park is too dark and that the addition of a light would improve safety. Staff agrees that the lighting is minimal and that a light would be a good addition to the park. Public Works has a 15-foot tall pole stored in the Yard that would allow us to implement this request for very little cost. We would recommend installing this light in a high point in the center of the park area.

In order to be sure we will not be upsetting any adjacent neighbors with this improvement, we hand delivered notices of this meeting to all surrounding properties.
