MAINTENANCE

The maintenance function of the Public Works Department is divided into the following sections:

- ♦ Building Maintenance
- ◆ Equipment Service
- ♦ Parks/Medians

- ♦ Sewers/Storm Drains
- ♦ Street Lighting
- ♦ Street Maintenance/Traffic Safety

<u>Building Maintenance</u>: Painted the exterior of Base III; changed marquee; repaired Strand restroom plumbing; removed graffiti; set up and tore down for council chamber meetings; re-bulbed fixtures in the community Center; installed new basketball backboards in the gymnasium; prepared sand bags for predicted storms; prepared for New Year's Eve weekend; cleaned vehicles.

Equipment Service Division: Picked up and delivered new PD units; removed equipment from old PD units; cleaned assorted equipment; installed new tool boxes in pick ups; welded Kiwanis area handrail; installed new brake lathe; repaired sign at the PD; started smog program; prepped all storm drain and sewer pumps; cleaned hazardous waste area.

<u>Parks/Medians Division</u>: Repaired plumbing on the Pier; set up park closures for over-seeding at Valley Park and Clark Field; replaced all ball field lights; started dugout repairs; started painting for all of Clark Field; repaired swing sets on beach; finished Base III ground work; repaired drinking fountains along the Greenbelt; installed new benches at Fort Lots of Fun.

<u>Sewers/Storm Drain Division</u>: Opened all beach outlets; continued rodent abatement in City sewer lines; repaired broken sewer line at 16th; continued citywide sewer cleaning.

<u>Street Lighting/Medians Division</u>: Installed Christmas decorations; installed and took down banners; re-bulbed streetlights; finished citywide night survey; notified SCE regarding streetlight issues; replaced fixture at the end of the Pier.

<u>Street Maintenance/Traffic Safety Division</u>: Re-bulbed traffic signals; set up stealth traffic survey; prepped for New Year's weekend included clean up issues; removed Christmas tree and stage; restriped parking Lot E; replaced signs on poles citywide; repaired meter poles; built berms for storm water control.
