PROPOSED FY 2007-08 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BUDGET

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Public Works Commission receive and file this report from staff on proposed Capital Improvement Program (CIP) budget for Fiscal Year 07-08.

Summary:

Staff will review the proposed Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget for FY 07-08 (see attached). The total budget proposed for new projects is \$3,833,338. Included in this amount is \$756,241 in Street Improvements; \$1,101,000 in Sewer Improvements; and \$1,976,097 in Building Improvements.

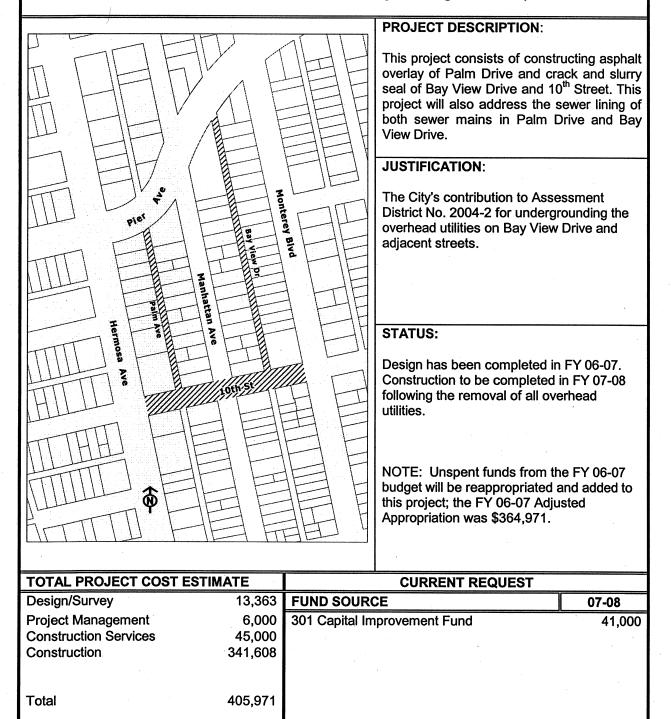

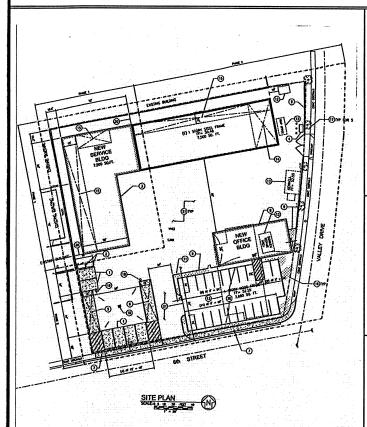

PHASE 3: Construction of new office building.

The current levels of operation and efficiency are constrained by the old facilities and the site layout. Consequently, it is difficult to conduct maintenance operations in a rapid and cost-effective manner.
